## AN ORDINANCE OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF COWETA COUNTY, GEORGIA TO AMEND CHAPTER 10. ANIMALS OF THE COWETA COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Coweta County, Georgia and it is hereby ordained by the authority of the same that Chapter 10. Animals, Section 10-154 be amended as follows:

**AMEND** Chapter 10. Animals, Section 10-154 Requirements for Possession and Confinement of a Dangerous or Vicious Dog, specifically (b)(4) as follows:

(4) The owner of a dangerous or vicious dog shall maintain a policy of general or specific liability insurance insuring the owner of the dangerous or vicious dog against liability for any bodily injury or property damage caused by the dog, which policy shall be issued by an insurer authorized to transact business in the state. The minimum amount shall be \$500,000.00 for a dangerous dog and \$1,000,000.00 for a vicious dog.
