4. L & A Testing- May 21, 2024

Director Gay advised the Board that L&A Testing for the May 21, 2024 Election will begin April 15th at 10:00 AM at the Elections Office and will continue until complete.

5. Early Voting- May 21, 2024

Director Gay advised that Early Voting for the May 21st Election will be April 29th to May 17th. Monday through Friday from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM with two Saturdays, May 4th and May 11th from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM. Both Early Voting locations will be open: Voter Registration 87 Newnan Station Drive and Central Community Center 65 Literary Lane.

She also advised that the deadline to register to vote is April 22nd, which is also the first day for Regular Absentee by Mail Ballots to be mailed. UOCAVA ballots started to be mailed out last week and the office has issued 27.

6. Other Business

Director Gay advised that at the end of 2023, due to a lawsuit our Senate District changed from 28 to 6. Staff conducted Redistricting and ordered new Precinct Cards. The office received the Precinct Cards and staff has mailed all of them. Around 114,921 cards.
